History of TFCC de Weirijders

Our club, established in September 1983 lies in the city of Tiel. The name "De Weirijders" originated when the founders of the BMX club were allocated a small meadow on Peppellaan in Tiel in 1983 to start BMX racing. BMX racing was very popular during those years, and soon it became apparent that the terrain at Peppellaan was too small. In 1985, a new location was found at the Hennepe in Tiel. Over the years, the BMX tracks became more challenging, partly due to the Olympic status, and with the starting hill getting higher. This necessitated the Weirijders to once again search for a new location again to keep up with the sport's development and to provide enough challenge for riders aiming to compete at the (inter)national level.

After a long search for a suitable location and financial resources, the new location on Schaarsdijkweg in Tiel was allocated. In 2017 and 2018, the new Cycling Sports Center "de Betuwe" was constructed with financial assistance from the Province of Gelderland and the Municipality of Tiel. Besides the BMX track, there is also a 1600-meter enclosed cycling track and cyclocross course belonging to cycling club JVR de Batauwens. This new location offers many more possibilities and soon after its opening in March 2018, the Weirijders membership grew, making it one of the largest BMX clubs in the Netherlands.

Throughout its existence, the Weirijders have had several European and World champions in the club, including riders such as Pieter Breddels, Maartje Hereijgers, Viviana van Hees, Jaymio Brink, Dorus Brink and Richard van Zomeren.

Since the opening, the Cycling Sports Center "de Betuwe" has hosted a wide variety of BMX and cycling events, such as Top Competition races, the Dutch Individual Championship, and the Dutch Club Championship. Now, it's time for the next step with the organization of the UEC BMX European Cup Rounds. It's a reward for the dedication of the board and the many volunteers who have supported the Weirijders for years.

2. TRACK DETAILS

The track was built in 2018 by a former member of the Dutch National BMX team Sander Bisseling in cooperation with ideas from Yann Bonici, Thomas Hamon, Richard van Zomeren and Dorus Brink.

Since it's opening the track went through a couple of changes created by Ewoud Stam, owner of ESSBL. This year, a reworked version of the first and third section is being implemented.

The 5-meter hill, equipped with a Pro Gate starting gate, serves as the start of the track with an extremely fast first section. The second section had a complete make-over last year. The Challenge section offers a technical but flowy whole. The new pro-section offers big jumps including a big step-up, a true challenge for the Championship classes. The reworked third section includes a gathering of jumps, where the very technical rider will excel. Finishing off with our last section, which is flowy and will be the thrilling end of loads of finals.



3. THE CITY OF TIEL

Tiel is one of the ten oldest cities in the Netherlands, centrally located in the heart of the Betuwe region. This area is well known for its delicious fruit. Get to know Tiel's city mascot, Flipje, the fruit character. Explore the historic centre with its charming shopping streets that reminds you of the Hanseatic period. It's very pleasant there, with different shops, restaurants and cafes, as well as beautiful parks and city gardens.

Around the year 800, Tiel was still a small farming village. But 200 years later, around the year 1000, Tiel had grown into a city of great importance where a lot of trade from around Europe took place. Very special is that Tiel had it's own toll station and currency at that time, which was quite rare for towns of this size. Trade made Tiel flourish; more people and more money came in. You can still see this in the city walls, rich merchant houses and warehouses for goods. Several buildings have been (partially) preserved and are very beautiful to see. Even the names of streets and squares still recall Tiel's trading history.

The 'Plein'

The 'Plein' (Square) was the city's harbor until 1646. After that, it was emptied of water, allowing it to fulfil other functions. The bronze statue of a cargo ship recalls the hanseatic past. Yet, there are more glimpses into the past. The houses on one side of the square are slightly higher because they stand on a former island called 'de Kleyberg'. This island was not under the city's jurisdiction, so people did not have to pay taxes here. This was very attractive for catering entrepreneurs. And with a location near the harbour, the entrepreneurs could offer the sailors cheap drinks. Even now, this is still a square filled with restaurants and cafes.

When you say jam or marmalade, you say Flipje. The great hero of Tiel even has his own statue and museum, the 'Flipje & Streekmuseum Tiel'. And rightly so, as Flipje – as well as the famous "Michelin man" - is one of the oldest marketing symbols in Europe.



The Maartenskerk (church) was built around the year 900. After that, it has often been expanded and restored. In the 15th century, it reached its largest size. However, parts of the church were destroyed in the following centuries. The church sustained heavy damage during WWII. The current paving around the building still shows the church at its peak size.

Always something to do in Tiel

In the theater Agnietenhof you can enjoy many wonderful performances and films. In the cultural complex Zinder, you'll find the library, a music school, exhibitions and a small concert hall. Visit Flipje and the 'Streekmuseum' and discover the history of Tiel and its region. You can also visit one of the swimming pools, go play padel, bowling, glow-in-the-dark mini-golf, skateboarding or feed and pet animals at the deer park. From June to August, you can pick delicious cherries in Tiel!

And for water lovers, Tiel is an experience due to its location near the river Waal, the river Linge and the Amsterdam-Rhine Canal. You can rent a canoe or a SUP board to paddleboard on the river Linge. You can go fishing or take a boat tour on the river! Tiel and the Betuwe are also an excellent place for beautiful walks and bike rides.

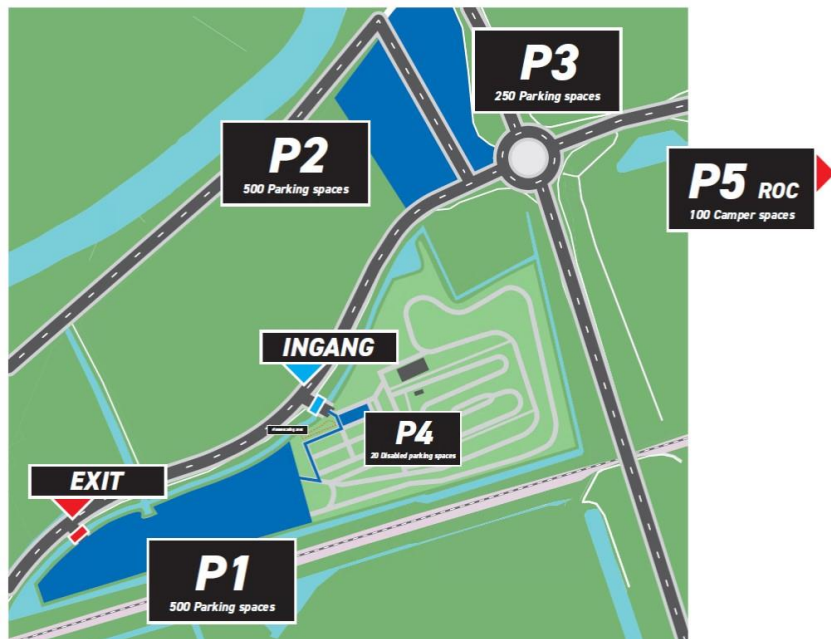

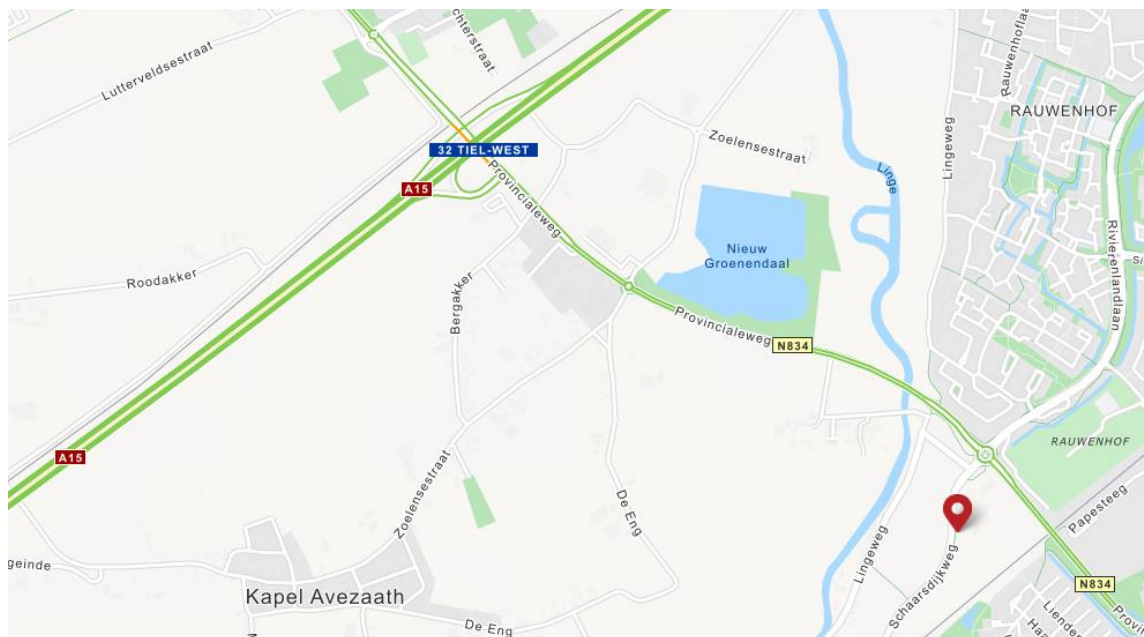
By car

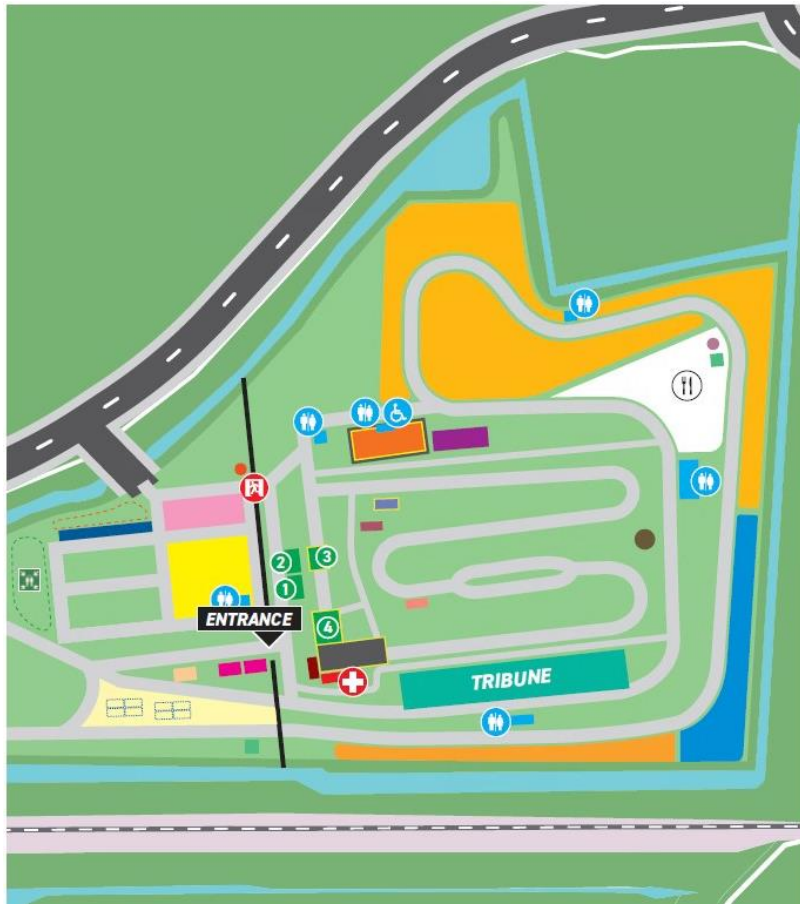

The 2024 registration fees, excluding administration fee* and bank costs** are the following:

Registration and payment details

- You can only register for an event by paying the applicable fees directly.
- *Administration fee is € 1,50 per rider, per round, per class.
- **Bank costs depend on your method of payment and will be charged directly.
- After registration you receive a confirmation mail from JSTiming.
Note: this email might be in your spam box.
- Cancellation costs are € 5,00 plus administration/bank costs € 1,50 per rider.
- After cancellation you receive a cancellation email from JSTiming.
- Refunds will follow after the deadline for cancellations.

Late entries

Late entries are possible for all riders until deadline for late entries, paying double entry fee. The deadline for late entries can be found on the event page in the registration portal. Registration or payment at the event are NOT POSSIBLE

Deadline cancellations

The deadline for cancellations can also be found on the event page in the registration portal. In case of a cancellation, the entry fee will be refunded. Cancellation fee, administration fee and bank costs (per rider, per round) still must be paid. These fees will be deducted from the paid entry fees.

Rider confirmation

All team managers and Chef d'Equipe must attend the rider confirmation on Friday at the Welcome centre to confirm their riders' participation for the event.

Transponders

All riders in Challenge 15/16 and Championships classes (Junior, U23 and Elite) require a UEC transponder to be able to participate. The transponders are provided by UEC. They will be provided in a bag per country to the Chef d'Equipe / team manager. Immediately after the race, the transponders for each country must be handed in by the Chef d'Equipe / team manager after the race. If a rider fails to return the transponder after the event, the UEC will send an invoice of €100.00 per transponder to the federation. The rider will not be able to participate in the next UEC BMX European Cup round until the invoice is paid.

Above apply both for all races of the UEC BMX European Cup.

10. RULES

The provisions of the latest version of the UCI's BMX Rulebook apply with a few amendments:

- Riders categories: as set forth in chapter 7.
- UEC BMX European Cup events are open to all riders who are licensed by a National Federation, with a minimum age of 8 years old. There is no limit in the number of riders a country can register.
- Event format Challenge categories: For all Challenge categories, excluded Boys 15/16 & Girls 15/16, scrambled seeding is used for the motos according to article 6.1.027quater of the UCI BMX Rulebook.
- The posting of race information including start lists and results will be done electronically at every event of the UEC BMX European Cup events.

- Number of motos: in case of special conditions (weather, wind or else) or a high number of participants, the UEC BMX Commission allows the PCP in agreement with the UEC Technical delegate to reduce the number of motos. This can only apply for challenge classes and never for championship classes.

Event format Challenge category Boys 15/16, Girls 15/16 and Championship categories:

- the UCI BMX World Cup system is used according to articles 6.3.009 till 6.3.014 of the latest version of the UCI BMX Rulebook.
- Riders are not automatically entered in both Rounds of each UEC BMX European Cup event. During riders confirmation on Friday, riders can opt to participate in only 1 Round during the UEC BMX European Cup event.
- All riders in Championships categories and Challenge 15/16 require a UEC transponder to participate in UEC BMX European Cup Rounds. The rider is responsible to have the assigned transponder correctly attached to the bike at all times during racing, warmup and practice.

Rider's equipment:

- All riders receive a number plate and side plate from UEC at registration of the UEC BMX European Cup Race. In all UEC sanctioned BMX events a rider must display the number plate and side plate assigned to him. A rider who fails to display the correct number plates will be refused their start, or relegated, if it is noticed after beginning a heat or run.
- All Championship and Challenge riders must either wear a clearly visible national flag of their country on both shoulders or the national jersey of their country.
- If a Championship rider is National Champion in their class, this rider must wear either:
 - o the jersey awarded by the federation,
 - o a replica of that jersey with publicity in the spaces allowed by the regulations,
 - o their normal jersey with the left sleeve designed to look like the flag of their country

All riders, coaches, parents, commissaires, personnel and visitors must respect Covid-19 rules implemented by the organiser.

Team manager meeting

Team Managers meeting will be on Friday, as indicated in the time schedule. The location of the meeting will be indicated at the event. The participation is mandatory for: max. 1 National Delegate (Chef d'Equipe); max. 1 Team Manager of the UEC registered team; max. 1 Team manager of UCI registered team, max. 2 National BMX Coaches (registered by National federation).

If necessary, the UEC Technical delegate and PCP can decide to call for other meetings during the event.

11. ACCREDITATION

A Chef d'Equipe or his nominated staff is accredited by the UEC with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UCI Regulations or noncompliance with the instructions of the organisation or the Commissaires' panel.

Members of the country delegations will receive accreditation at all UEC events according to the following schedule if they register their staff. Please send an email to jolandapolkamp@gmail.com before the event with the names of the staff members.

All athletes will be given a wristband so that they can reach all areas necessary.

National Teams

Each National Championships team must register their staff (Championship coach, doctor, other staff members) must be registered. Please send an email to jolandapolkamp@gmail.com before the event. UCI teams have the same rights as national teams.

Chef d'Equipe

Each federation that pre-registers riders must appoint a Chef d'Equipe (national team manager) to represent the interests of all of its riders. Each Chef d'Equipe must confirm the presence of each rider as per the pre-registration riders list at rider confirmation, as indicated in the timing schedule.

Mandatory registration of staff before the event

Before each event a national federation must register their Chef d'Equipe and the whole team, the registration will be checked at the event. Please send an email with the names of the staff members to jolandapolkamp@gmail.com before the event.

Chef d'Equipe, Team managers and assistants must present a license from the federations. UEC will check the registration of the staff and then they will be given the accreditation. Without a registration UEC will not give out accreditation.

National BMX coaches

UEC acknowledges official BMX National coaches for European Cup. National federations can register their coaches. They will be provided with accreditation per race. A country can register max 2 coaches per country per race.

Personal BMX coaches

Championships riders who come to the event with a personal BMX coach are offered the possibility to buy a Coach accreditation. This accreditation costs €150 per weekend. This allows you access to the team manager meeting and coach area. This coach accreditation can be bought at the Welcome Centre on Friday during rider confirmation.



12. 2024 UEC BMX EUROPEAN CUP TEAM RANKING & TEAM AREA

UEC Registered teams

UEC teams (<http://www.uec.ch/en/teamsbmx>) must confirm their 4-rider participation on Friday at rider confirmation before each event (see time schedule). Team managers have to fill-in the team Entry form. In return for the registration, they receive accreditation for the event.

Accreditation team manager

Teams only receive accreditation when they enter the team competition at the event. A UEC BMX team manager or his nominated assistant is accredited with the right to enter a restricted zone in order to perform his duties. Such accreditation may be revoked for any breach of the UEC or UCI Regulations or non-compliance with the instructions of the organisation or the commissaires' panel.

Team Spaces for UEC registered teams

UEC Teams must register team spaces as indicated in the event Technical Guide. The organiser will provide spaces for team tents to UEC registered teams, or 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of €150 per team space. This includes 1x free event entry ticket (pass-partout) per team tent space paid for.

For all rules concerning UEC BMX European Cup Team Ranking see European Cup Team Rules document on UEC website (www.uec.ch/en/bmx-european-cup).

Team Spaces for other teams

The organiser can provide spaces for team tents to non-UEC registered teams, of 6 x 3 m for each team, at the cost of € 200,00. These teams receive 1 free event ticket (pass-partout) from the organizer per team tent (6x3m).

13. PRIZE MONEY AND TROPHIES

Prize money Championship classes

The prize money will be paid directly by the organiser directly after the prize ceremony.

Podium ceremony

Only Championship riders who come in 1st to 3rd place are obligated to attend the podium ceremony in race uniform.

UEC requires a clean podium photo without commercial attributes, like helmets, goggles or bikes, for media purposes. Afterwards riders may take photos with commercial items.

Prize money (per round)

The prize money will be increased by 10% with more than 1.000 participants registered per day.

The ranking of the 2024 BMX European Cup will only be established for all Challenge categories 13 years and over. Categories 12 years and younger will not have an overall ranking.

The 2024 Overall Ranking ceremony for all categories will be held after the award ceremony of Round 12 in Ravels (Belgium).

2024 Overall UEC BMX European Cup Teams Ranking

The overall award ceremony will be held after Round 12 of the 2024 UEC BMX European Cup with the Top 3 Team coaches and maximum 4 riders per team.

The UEC BMX European Cup Teams ranking will take into consideration all rounds.



The UEC BMX Commission will award Prizemoney to the 3 first teams at the end of 12 rounds. The overall prize money is paid to teams when at least 6 rounds of the UEC BMX European Cup have been organised.

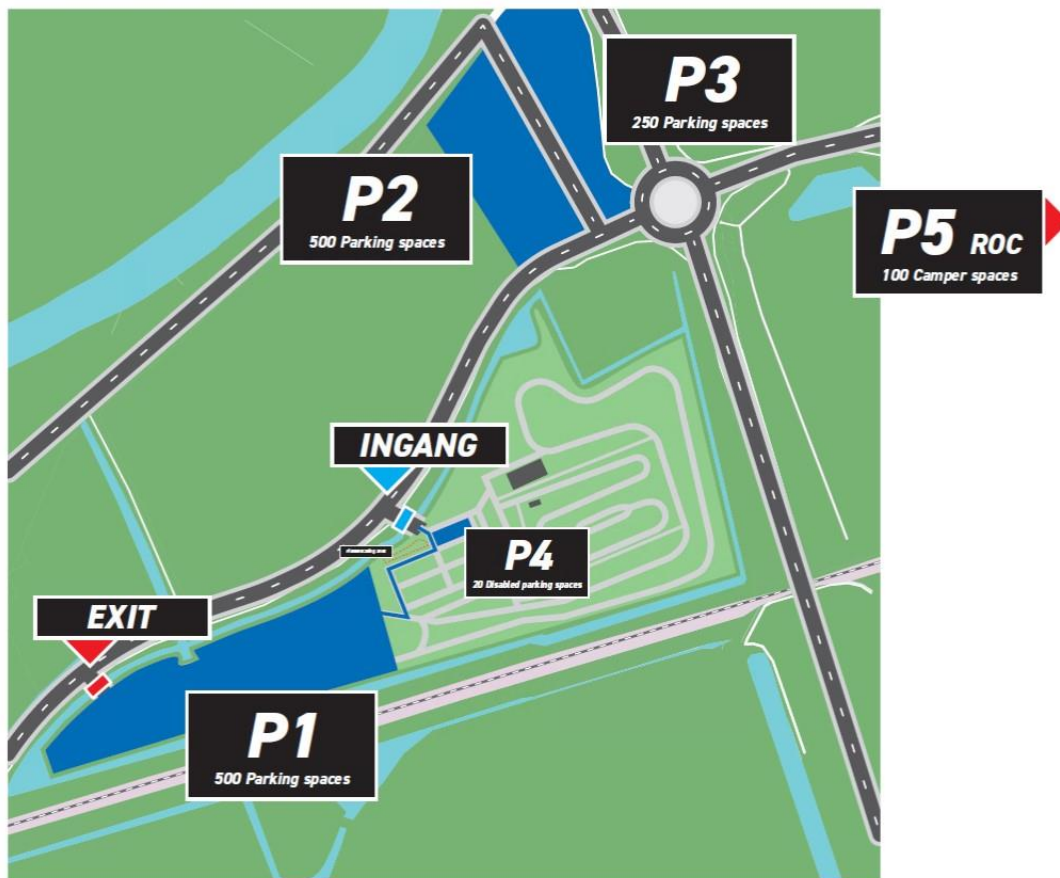

19. PARKING

Free. P1-P3 all visitors, except P4 for disabled and P5 for campers.

All parking lots are within walking distance to the bmx track. Please follow the signs to get to the bmx track. P5 for Campers is only for parking on Saturday and Sunday, not allowed on Friday!

Please note: Parking is allowed only on all parking lots. Overnight stays in the parking areas are NOT permitted.



20. CATERING

There will be several well equipped catering stands, where you can buy hot and cold food and drinks.

21. SHOPS

A BMX Village and a local market will be set up during the UEC BMX European Cup. If you would like your BMX shop to be present send an e-mail to: uctiel@gmail.com to reserve your space in the BMX Village or ask for more information. Mention your shop name, the person responsible, your time of arrival and departure, and how much space you need (incl. market stall, bus or car, trailer etc. Price is € 250,- excl. vat for 12m x 6m. A larger space will be charged extra.

22. PRESS

Press accreditation for the event may be granted only to accredited journalists in possession of an ID card issued by the national press association. Accreditation for the events must be done through the UEC website for all UEC events <http://uec.ch/en/media>.

During the UEC BMX European Cup events accreditation and BIB's will be handed out by UEC. It is mandatory to wear UEC press BIB's for the journalists on the track. The UEC will provide them and have someone responsible for their distribution.

The number of journalists on the track at the same time must be agreed by the PCP depending on the track space/size.

Press conferences, flash interviews etc. must be agreed with the UEC BMX Commission.

For all publications the UEC logo as well as the UEC main sponsor logo should be used in accordance with UEC graphic charter.

General rules

- At every UEC BMX event BIB's are used for press on and off the track.
- The distribution of the BIB at the events is done by the indicated UEC official.
- During the events, five red Bibs' (of which one for the UEC photographer) are distributed, the rest of the photographers get a yellow BIB.
- The BIB distribution is examined separately for Challenge and Championship classes
- A guarantee for each BIB is mandatory: € 20 or an official document (driver's license, identity card, press card ...)
- By failing to comply with the regulations or the instructions of officials, the BIB can be taken from a photographer immediately.
- Be careful when using flash. Do not flash directly into the eyes of the riders.
- Photographers must be impartial on the track; it is not allowed to cheer for a rider in the track.
- It is strictly forbidden to touch a rider and / or bicycle.
- It's forbidden to walk across the photo finish line. This can cause problems for the people of the photo finish cameras.
- A photographers meeting can be organized. This will be announced in advance in a timely manner.

Drones

- Drones might be allowed after consultation with the UEC responsible, providing they are allowed by local laws. The pilot must hold a valid pilot license and there must be compliance with all regulations regarding the airline (flight plan etc.) Moreover, the minimum and the maximum height are fixed according to the regulations of the country. Failure to comply with all the proposed rules will be reported to the police.

23. MEDICAL INFORMATION

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout practice and racing. The team will be based on the track and have use of a medical room at the bottom of the start ramp. The medical team will be available at the following times:
